3. Attend the meeting to learn about the duties that go with that guild/liturgical role.
3. If you are still interested, you can specify which particular aspect of the role you would like to help out with. (ex: you love landscaping but *hate* maintenance or you want to be involved with Fr. Kapaun stuff, but *don't* want to give tours.). You can also specify a location if applicable.
4. The commitment period is 1 year until the next stewardship renewal. At that point, you can choose to continue in your role or check out a different one.
