PARISH NEWS

- **Tabor** students will gather on Tuesday, February 10th in the evening for **adoration**. Please keep the students and Parishioners who volunteer in the Tabor Guild in prayer.
- **Ash Wednesday** is February 18th. Masses will be at **Marion at Noon**, and **Pilsen at 7pm**. The faithful are asked to fast and abstain on Ash Wednesday as the season of fasting and abstinence begins.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are **obligatory days of fasting and abstinence**. Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards. The fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil as the "**paschal fast**" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection. - The most important days of the year as Catholics occur at the beginning of April this year. Holy Triduum will take place at **Pilsen** this year.
 - **April 2** Holy Thursday: Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper is at **7pm at Pilsen** with Adoration following.
 - **April 3** Good Friday: The Celebration of the Passion of the Lord is at **3pm at Pilsen**. The Procession of the Way of the Cross will begin prior.
 - **April 4** Holy Saturday: Easter Vigil in the Holy Night is at **9pm at Pilsen**.
 - **April 5** Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord: **8:30am at Marion & 10:30am at Florence**.
- **The Rite of Election** Saturday, February 21 at 11am at the Church of the Magdalen. Our Parish is welcoming many folks into full communion over the next few months. Please pray for all those who desire the Sacraments as they prepare for full initiation.
