- **No Daily Mass** February 24th - 27th Please pray for the pilgrims in Medjagorie. **Email any prayer requests to the Parish Office.**
- Mark your calendar for the **Penitential Celebration on March 25th at 6:30pm** at Pilsen.
- The most important days of the year as Catholics occur at the beginning of April this year. Holy Triduum will take place at Pilsen.
 - April 2 Holy Thursday: **Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper is at 7pm** at Pilsen with Adoration following.
 - April 3 Good Friday: **The Celebration of the Passion of the Lord is at 3pm** at Pilsen. The Procession of the Way of the Cross will begin prior.
 - April 4 Holy Saturday: **Easter Vigil in the Holy Night is at 9pm** at Pilsen.
 - April 5 Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord: **8:30am at Marion & 10:30am at Florence.**

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are **obligatory days of fasting and abstinence**. Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards. The fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil as the "**paschal fast**" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection.
