Q Why celebrate the end of Harvest with Mass?

a "He is always able to save those who approach God through him, since he lives forever to make intercession for them" (Heb 7:25). The Sacrifice of the Mass makes present to the faithful Christ's eternal act of intercession for us. In that sense, the Mass is the Church's greatest intercessory prayer. - USCCB

Q Why a Marian Procession?

a October is the month of the Holy Rosary. October was first dedicated to the rosary—a set of prayers said in honor of the Blessed Mother—because Pope St. Pius V credited the Holy League's victory at the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571, to the praying of the rosary that he had enjoined upon all Christians in preparation for the battle.

Q Why does Holy Family Parish celebrate festivals and processions?
