### Feast Days for the week of April 28th

Mon., St. Catherine of Siena, virgin, doctor of the church: Catherine, died 1380; O.P. tertiary, mystic, & author (*The Dialogue*); peacemaker within the Church & renewer of religious life; worked toward ending the Avignon papacy under Gregory XI; declared doctor of the Church in 1970; patroness of Italy and, together with St. Bridget of Sweden & St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross, co-patroness of Europe.  
Tues., St. Pius V, Pope: Pius V, died May 1, 1572; O.P. who implemented the reforms of the Council of Trent; promulgated the *Roman Catechism*, the *Roman Missal*, & the *Roman Breviary*; canonized May 22, 1712.  
Wed., St. Joseph the Worker  
Thur., St. Athanasius, bishop, doctor of the Church: Athanasius, died 373; bishop of Alexandria 45 years; champion of Nicea; prolific polemicist against the Arians who exiled him 5 times; one of the 4 great doctors of the Eastern Church; known as the "Doctor of the Incarnation."  
Fri., Sts. Philip & James, Apostles: Philip, died 1st cen.; from Bethsaida; among the 1st disciples called by Jesus; tradition holds he preached in Phrygia, dying on a cross at Hierapolis; with James, venerated as the patron saints of Uruguay. James, died 62; son of Alphaeus; surnamed "the Less"; an epistle is ascribed to him; believed to have been beaten or stoned to death; patron of the dying; both saints mentioned in the Roman Canon.

to bring side dishes.

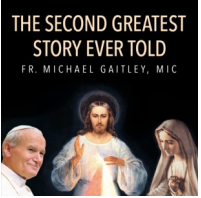

Our Lord Jesus said to St. Faustina in the early years of the 20th Century, “My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come forth from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy.”

A plenary indulgence can be received on Divine Mercy Sunday by the following: the exclusion of all attachment to sin, even venial sin, the performance of the indulgenced work (doing an act of mercy) and fulfillment of the three conditions: sacramental confession, receive Holy Communion, and prayer for the pope’s intentions. The condition requiring prayer for the pope’s intentions is satisfied by reciting once the Our Father and Hail Mary for his intentions.

The Divine Mercy Novena begins on Good Friday and ends on Divine Mercy Sunday, the Sunday after Easter. Divine Mercy booklets are available in the back of church for everyone to take home.
