Mon., St. Charles Lwanga & Companions, martyrs: Charles Lwanga & 21 Ugandan Companions, died Nov. 15, 1885 - Jan. 27, 1887; proto-martyrs of Black Africa; over 100 killed in this period, including Anglicans; Charles is the patron saint of African Catholic Youth Action. **Tues., Easter Weekday** **Wed., St. Boniface, bishop, martyr:** Boniface, died 754; Anglo-Saxon O.S.B.; founded abbey of Fulda; bishop of Mainz; martyred along with 30 companions at Dokkum in Frisia; known as the "Apostle of Germany." **Thur., St. Norbert, bishop:** Norbert, died 1134; founded the Premonstratensians or "Norbertines," today numbering about 1,270 members; archbishop of Magdeburg; strong supporter of Church reform & evangelization; devoted to the Holy Eucharist. **Fri., Easter Weekday** **Sat., Easter Weekday** **Pentecost Sunday:** Acts 2:1-11 1 Cor 12:3b-7, 12-13 Jn 20:19-23

ASCENSION OF OUR LORD

Have you ever tried to imagine the feelings of Jesus & His disciples on the day of the ascension? That day may well have been a bittersweet occasion for Jesus. He must have been filled with joyous anticipation: pain & suffering were behind Him. He was about to enter triumphantly into His Father's glory. He was preparing to pour out His Holy Spirit on the face of the earth.

The look of puzzled uncertainty on the faces of His followers must have touched His heart. He would never again be with these friends in the old, familiar ways. Were they really ready for this next big step in their life of union with Him? Could they make it on their own without His visible support?

Saying good-bye is never easy—for the one who is going or for the one who is left behind. Most of us have been on both sides of a farewell. We have sent sons or daughters off to school or down the aisle; we have suffered the death of a beloved relative or friend. The ascension can help us to realize that good byes are not just occasions for tears, they are opportunities for growth as well.

The disciples who walked away from the Mount of Olives on Ascension Day were a very different bunch from those who ran away from Calvary a short time before. When Jesus said farewell to His apostles on the night before he died, they were not prepared to understand or accept what He was trying to say. They wanted to hang onto Him like dependent children and force Him to fulfill their childish dreams of the kingdom. When He was taken away, they fell apart.

Yet, after Jesus left the disciples on Ascension Day, Luke tells us, they “went back into Jerusalem, filled with great joy, and spent all their time in the Temple giving thanks to God” (Lk 24:52-53). In the days after the resurrection He helped them to understand: You may feel you cannot live without Me standing beside you, showing you the way, telling you what to do. You may feel little and weak, unequal to the task of carrying on my mission and renewing the earth. But you are wrong. I am not deserting you—I am going away in order to send you a gift that my Father and I have prepared for you: “In a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.” (Acts 1:5)

Like the apostles, we have reason to face the goodbyes of our lives with courage and joy. The strength we need to carry on and keep growing is hidden in our hearts, waiting to be released. May the Spirit of the Lord be with you! ~The Edmindite

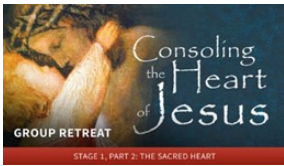

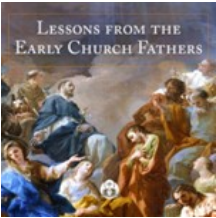

STUDY: “Consoling the Heart of Jesus” ~June 8—Sacred Heart of Jesus~



PENTECOST: A feast of the universal Church which commemorates the Descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles, fifty days after the Resurrection of Christ. Pentecost is next Sunday, June 9th. It is known as the “birthday of the Church.” The word Pentecost comes from a Greek word that means fiftieth day. In the Old Testament, it was known as the Feast of Weeks, since it occurred after a week of weeks (7 times 7 = 49) after Passover. It was also known as the Feast of Harvest or the Day of Firstfruits. The Jews also commemorated the promulgation of the Law on Mount Sinai on this day. In the New Testament, the Christians celebrated the completion of Christ's work through the coming of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles that gave birth to the Church. The followers of Christ filled with the Holy Spirit and strengthened and encouraged by His grace are fired up to spread the Gospel to all nations as they themselves live and proclaim the Gospel. For them this feast also commemorated the promulgation of the New Law.



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• **Totus Tuus** will be held in our parish in Pilsen the week of June 23-28. Totus Tuus is a fun and energetic parish-based summer catechetical program for grade school age through high school youth of Holy Family Parish. **Daily Mass will be at 11:30am Wed.—Fri., please wear pants or skirts.**
• For **Grade school children** (grades 1-6) the program runs Monday-Friday from 9:00am-3:00pm. Includes catechetical instruction, daily Mass, songs, games, and recess. Children should bring a sack lunch and recess equipment.
• For **High school and junior high youth:** Sunday-Thursday from 7:30pm-9:45pm. The evening sessions include talks on topics of interest to young Catholics, the opportunity for Adoration and the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and a night of fellowship with the team members.
