talk about various aspects of the Fr. Kapaun story, such as the miracles. The parish is welcome to the speaker meeting at the Kroupa's.

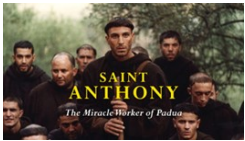
