Feast Days for the week of June 16th

Mon., Weekday Tues., Weekday Wed., St. Romuald, abbot:

Romuald, died 1027; from Ravenna; founded the Camaldolese hermits, today numbering about 100 members; urged contemplative prayer through solitude, silence & fasting. Thur., Weekday Fri., St. Aloysius Gon-

zaga, religious: Aloysius Gonzaga, Jesuit scholastic, died 1591 at age 23 caring for the sick; from the princely family of Castiglione; a page at the

court of the Medicis and of Philip II of Spain; renounced inheritance to enter the Jesuits; St. Robert Bellarmine was his spiritual director; strongly devoted to the Eucharist, interior prayer, & charitable service; patron of youth & of students in Jesuit colleges & universities. Sat., St. Paulinus of Nola, Bishop; Sts. John Fisher, Bishop, & Thomas More, Martyrs: Paulinus, died 431; husband & father who gave his possessions to the poor; dedicated bishop, especially during the Visigoth invasions. John Fisher, beheaded 1535; chancellor of Cambridge University; bishop of Rochester; renowned for his preaching & educational reforms; defender of Church tradition against Luther, & of the Roman primacy against Henry VIII. Thomas More, beheaded 1535; humanist & chancellor of England; wrote *Utopia*; refused to support Henry VIII's divorce of Queen Catherine & his Act of Supremacy; patron of lawyers, statesmen, & politicians.

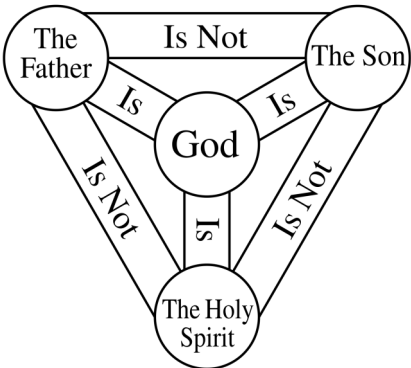

PILGRIMAGE TO EUROPE: Is there any interest in taking an 11 day trip to Germany, Switzerland & Austria in 2020? Besides visiting the Shrine of the Black Madonna and the birthplace of Pope Benedict XVI, the trip would include *The Passion Play of Oberammergau*: in keeping with their 387-year-old promise, the villagers of Oberammergau, Germany, present their Passion Play, depicting the last week of the life of Jesus Christ. It is only held every 10 years. The Oberammergau Passion Play was first performed in 1634. It resulted from a vow made by the inhabitants of the village that if God spared them from the effects of the bubonic plague then sweeping the region, they would perform a passion play every ten years. The death rate from this plague among adults had risen from one person per 1,000 per year in October 1632 to twenty in the month of March 1633. After their vow, the adult death rate slowly subsided to one in the month of July 1633. The villagers believed they had been spared and thus kept their part of the vow when the play was first performed in 1634. Since its first production it has been performed on open-air stages in the village. The play is now performed in years ending with a zero, as well as in 1934 which was the 300th anniversary and 1984 which was the 350th anniversary (though the 1940 performance was cancelled due to the onset of the Second World War in 1939). It involves over 2,000 actors, singers, instrumentalists and technicians, all residents of the village. Contact the church office as soon as possible if you're interested.
