Feast Days for the week of June 23rd

Mon., Nativity of St. John the Baptist: This feast, dating from the 4th century, came to be celebrated, in accord with Lk 1:36, six months before the Lord's birth; quoting Jn 3:30, Augustine found this date (near the summer solstice) appropriate for, after the birth of John, daylight begins to grow shorter, whereas after Jesus' birth, it begins to increase.

Tues., Weekday **Wed., Weekday** **Thur., St. Cyril of Alexandria, Bishop, Doctor of the Church:** Cyril, died 444; defended Mary as "God-bearer" at the Council of Ephesus against the Nestorians; spokesman for orthodoxy; noted especially for his Christological formulations; supported growth of Egyptian monasticism. **Fri., The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus** **Sat., Sts. Peter & Paul, Apostles:** Peter, died c. 64 in Rome under Nero; Galilean fisherman; spokesman for the Twelve who became "Prince of the Apostles"; two epistles are ascribed to him; patron of those in the fishing industry. Paul was martyred in Rome c. 67; Pharisee who became the "Apostle of the Gentiles"; his letters may be dated from c. 50-65; patron of the lay apostolate, the Cursillo Movement, & Catholic Action; also Malta & Greece.

PILGRIMAGE TO EUROPE: Is there any interest in taking an 11 day trip to Germany, Switzerland & Austria in 2020? Besides visiting the Shrine of the Black Madonna and the birthplace of Pope Benedict XVI, the trip would include The *Passion Play of Oberammergau*: in keeping with their 387-year-old promise, the villagers of Oberammergau, Germany, present their Passion Play, depicting the last week of the life of Jesus Christ. It is only held every 10 years. The Oberammergau Passion Play was first performed in 1634. It resulted from a vow made by the inhabitants of the village that if God spared them from the effects of the bubonic plague then sweeping the region, they would perform a passion play every ten years. The death rate from this plague among adults had risen from one person per 1,000 per year in October 1632 to twenty in the month of March 1633. After their vow, the adult death rate slowly subsided to one in the month of July 1633. The villagers believed they had been spared and thus kept their part of the vow when the play was first performed in 1634. Since its first production it has been performed on open-air stages in the village. The play is now performed in years ending with a zero, as well as in 1934 which was the 300th anniversary and 1984 which was the 350th anniversary (though the 1940 performance was cancelled due to the onset of the Second World War in 1939). It involves over 2,000 actors, singers, instrumentalists and technicians, all residents of the village. Contact the church office as soon as possible if you're interested.

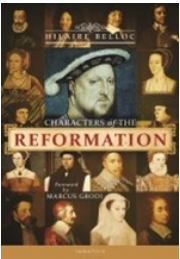

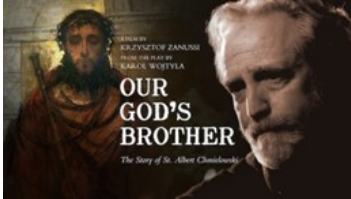
