Mass Readings for the week of July 14th
Mon., St. Bonaventure, bishop, doctor of the Church: Bonaventure, died 1274; O.F.M. minister general for 17 years; Cardinal bishop of Albano; authored biblical commentaries & many ascetical & spiritual treatises; known as the “Seraphic Doctor.”
Tues., Our Lady of Mount Carmel Wed.: Weekday
Thur., St. Camillus de Lellis, priest: Camillus de Lellis, died 1614 at Rome; soldier addicted to gambling; his conversion led him to found a society, today numbering 1,130 religious, which established hospitals & cared for the sick with affection & diligence; patron of nurses, of the sick, & of hospitals. Fri.: Weekday Sat., St. Apollinaris, bishop, martyr: Apollinaris, died 1st century; early accounts report that he was ordained bishop by St. Peter himself & sent as a missionary bishop to Ravenna during the reign of the emperor Claudius. Renowned for his power to heal in the name of Christ, he was frequently exiled, tortured, & imprisoned for the faith, & finally martyred.

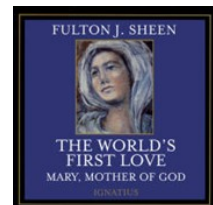


Fr. Bebak is turning 60!



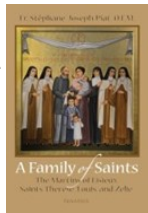

BIKING FOR BABIES: Once again, members of the parish were treated to inspirational stories from the young people who biked through our area. These young "missionaries" were raising awareness of the pro-life movement, while also raising money for pregnancy crisis centers. Only young people ages 18—35 are riders in the



Biking for Babies program, so as to inspire other young people to spread the pro-life message. By 2020 Biking for Babies wants to hit the "million dollar mark", giving \$1,000,000+ over the life of the organization to life-affirming pregnancy resource centers. This year there were 4 groups of bicyclists riding different routes across the U.S., meeting in St. Louis. They rode a total of over 2,500 miles, covered in 7 days. Thanks to Dale & Pat Smith for hosting the team overnight.

TOTAL CONSECRATION TO MARY: The Spiritual Life Center is consecrating itself to Mary under the title of "Our Lady of Wichita" (see below). The Monday night Study Group is joining the faithful of the Wichita Diocese, and invites the entire parish, in this consecration to Mary using the book "33 Days to Morning Glory". The preparation starts on July 13th for a consecration on August 15th, the Assumption of Mary. Books are in the back of church. It's an inspiring book to deepen your relationship with Our Lady if you've never done the consecration, or a good time to renew your consecration if you've done it before.



This icon at the Spiritual Life Center in Wichita titled "Our Lady of Wichita" has Our Lady holding Our Lord, and He is holding the Cathedral of our Diocese. Holy cards of this image with a prayer on the back can be added to your prep for the consecration. They are in the back of church, or you can use this image.

The Our Lady of Wichita icon was written by Mark Miller in 2017 for the Catholic Diocese of Wichita, and depicts Mary tenderly holding the Christ Child, who in turn is holding the Cathedral of Wichita. It is displayed at the Spiritual Life Center in Wichita, Kansas.
