Mass Readings for the week of July 21st: Mon., St. Mary Magdalene: Mary Magdalene, died 1st c.; healed of possession; disciple of Jesus & present at His crucifixion; in Mark, the first to witness to the risen Lord (hence, called the “apostle of the Apostles”); patroness of the Order of Preachers. Tues., St. Bridget, religious: Bridget, died 1373 in Rome; born in Sweden; mother of 8; mystic prophet & foundress of the Order of the Most Holy Savior; sought to end the luxury & dissipation of the Avignon papacy & the return of the pope to Rome; her *Revelations* record her spiritual experiences & life; patroness of Sweden; with St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross & St. Catherine of Siena, declared co-patroness of Europe by Pope John Paul II. Wed., St. Sharbel Makhluf, priest: Sharbel Makhluf, died 1898; born in 1828 in Lebanon, he became a monk of the Maronite Rite & was ordained a priest in 1859. Devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary, he spent the last 23 years of his life as a hermit. Despite temptations to wealth & comfort, Sharbel taught the value of poverty, self-sacrifice, & prayer by the life he lived. He possessed the gift of performing miracles even during his lifetime. Canonized by Pope Paul VI in 1977, Sharbel is known as the “Hermit of Lebanon.” Thur., St. James, Apostle: James, brother of John, is called “the Greater” because he followed Christ before the other apostle of the same name; first of the 12 to be martyred, being decapitated by order of Herod Agrippa I, c. 44; venerated at Compostella, Spain; named in the Roman Canon; patron of pilgrims, of Spain, Guatemala, & Nicaragua. Fri., Sts. Joachim & Anne, parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary: Names for the parents of Mary found in the 2nd c. *Protoevangelium of James*; veneration of Anne originated in the 6th c. East; patroness of childless women & miners; devotion to Joachim dates from the 8th c.; patron of fathers & grandparents. THE SCAPULAR

FROM THE Pastor's Desk

We have it on the word of the Holy Father that the scapular is in the first rank of the Marian devotions which especially enlighten minds with divine truths and excite souls to good Christian lives; that "the faithful of various nations have put on the scapular that, under the inspiration of the Mother of God, they may grow in the likeness of her divine Son, Jesus Christ."

What is there in the simple sacramental of the scapular that makes it so powerful an expression of devotion for the Blessed Mother? The devoted wearing of the scapular is the response of her sons and daughters to Mary's motherly love. Mothers clothe their children, with garments and with love. As Mary clothed the Christ-Child in swaddling clothes, and, as it is believed, even in the seamless robe that was stripped from Him on Calvary; so also she has clothed the children of her choice in the garment of the scapular. On the part of those who wear it gratefully and worthily, the scapular expresses complete confidence in Mary's assistance. For she is the queen who possesses a true role in her Son's kingdom of grace and who will obtain for her children whatever they need.

The small scapular is a Carmelite habit in miniature; by means of it Catholics call on Mary, Mother of Carmel, to keep them ever close to Christ. By being clothed in the scapular a Catholic is in a sense incorporated into the Carmelite Order. He is made part of the "family of Our Blessed Mother and attached to it by a special bond of love" (Pope Pius XII).

It is instructive to note that the Church's official prayers for imposing the scapular do not mention the famous scapular promises, but do emphasize the share in the life of the Carmelite order—for this is the means to merit Mary's approval. As St. Therese of the Child Jesus once wrote to a cousin: "I am so happy that you are wearing the blessed scapular; it is a sure sign of predestination; and over and above that it unites you more intimately with your little sisters in Carmel."

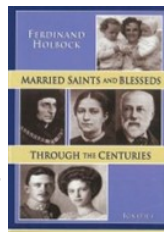
