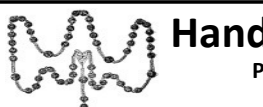
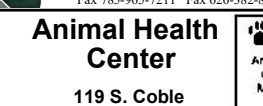
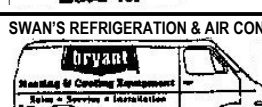

Mass Readings for the week of July 28th: Mon., **St. Martha:** Martha, died 1st c.; sister of Mary & Lazarus; model of hospitality & faithful disciple; confessed her faith in Jesus as the Son of God; patroness of housewives, waiters, & waitresses. Tues., **St. Peter Chrysologus, bishop, doctor of the Church:** Peter, died c. 450; called "Chrysologus", meaning "of gold-en speech" for his exceptional preaching ability; 170 homilies are extant; bishop of Ravenna. Wed., **St. Ignatius of Loyola, priest:** Ignatius, died 1556; soldier, founded the *Compania de Jesus*; approved by Pope Paul III in 1540; authored the *Spiritual Exercises*; founded the Roman College; at his death, the Society numbered 1,000 members in 76 houses in 12 provinces, including Brazil, Japan & India; today numbers some 16,740 members; patron saint of retreatants & soldiers.

Thur., **St. Alphonsus Liguori, bishop, doctor of the Church:** Alphonsus, died 1787; lawyer; founded the Redemptorists, today numbering some 5,120 members; opposed Jansenism, stressing Christ's love & Mary's help; bishop of St. Agata dei Goti; master of moral theology; patron of confessors & moral theologians. Fri., **St. Eusebius of Vercelli, bishop; St. Peter Julian Eymard, priest:** Eusebius, died 371; considered the founder of the canons regular in the West; exiled to Palestine by Constantius; with St. Hilary, an opponent of Arianism. Peter Julian Eymard, died Aug 1, 1868; founded the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament, today numbering some 875 members; founded the Servants of the Blessed Sacrament; influenced the founding of the Eucharistic Fraternity for the laity, the Association of Priest Adorers, & international Eucharistic congresses.

THE SCAPULAR

continued from last week....

"Wearing the Scapular is a Continual Prayer"

The scapular, a small garment worn day and night, is like a continual prayer. It is a constant reminder of Mary's virtues, because its very simplicity is a "mirror of humility and purity" (Pope Pius XII). The scapular is a school which offers us a "concise lesson in modesty and simplicity" (Pope Pius XII).

Those who wear it rightly bear not merely two bits of cloth over their shoulders, but deep in their souls they carry Mary's dedication to God's interests. Into the scapular Mary has woven all the qualities of her life. The scapular stands for the virtues of Mary herself. The Little Flower, St. Therese, in preparing for Holy Communion, used to ask our Blessed Mother to clothe her with her own dispositions and then present her to Christ. We do the same thing - by receiving the scapular from our Lady's hands, we ask to be clothed in her virtues and made more presentable to our Lord.

For more than seven centuries the scapular has been a sign of dedication to Mary. The highpoint of genuine scapular devotion has always been consecration to Mary, i.e., the giving over of one's self and one's life to our Blessed Mother. Consecration is a permanent state, a new and more intense relationship between our Lady and her Child, Jesus.

The Holy Father has brought this ancient and cherished truth to the fore once again by calling the scapular a sign of consecration to the most sacred heart of the Immaculate Virgin - that consecration which we have so strongly recommended in recent times.

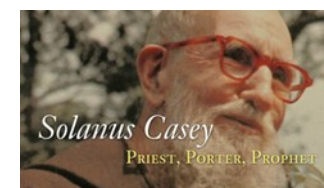

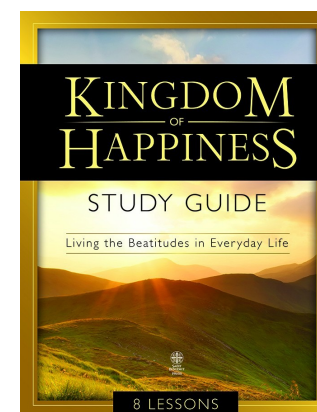
