Mass Readings for the week of August 4th: Mon., The Dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary Major: Following the declaration of Mary as "God-Bearer" by the Council of Ephesus in 431, Pope Sixtus III erected in Rome this oldest basilica in the West dedicated to the Mother of God. Tues., The Transfiguration of the Lord Wed., St. Sixtus II, pope, & Companions, martyrs; St. Cajetan, priest: Sixtus II & 4 deacons were arrested on Aug. 6, 258 while celebrating the Eucharist in the cemetery of Callistus; by order of Valerian, they were decapitated that same day; Sixtus named in Roman Canon. Cajetan, died 1547; from Venice; cofounded the Theatines, who number about 175 religious; devoted to reform, prayer, & ministry, especially to the poor & the sick. Thur., St. Dominic, priest: Dominic de Guzman, died Aug 6, 1221; founded the Order of Preachers, today numbering some 5,770 religious; an elective, fraternal form of community life devoted to contemplation, study, & preaching; sought to bring Albigensians back into the Church through preaching & living evangelical poverty; canonized in 1234. Fri., St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross, virgin, martyr: Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein) was born in Breslau, Germany in 1891 of Jewish parents. She was received into the Catholic Church in 1922, & in 1933 entered the Carmelite convent in Cologne where she received the name Teresa Benedicta of the Cross. In 1942 she was killed at Auschwitz. Along with St. Catherine of Siena & St. Bridget of Sweden, she was declared co-patroness of Europe by Pope John Paul II. Sat., St. Lawrence, deacon, martyr: Lawrence, died 258, four days after 4 other deacons & Pope Sixtus II were killed; cared for the temporal welfare of the Roman Church; said to have been burned alive on a gridiron; after Sts. Peter & Paul, Lawrence is venerated as patron of Rome; mentioned in the Roman Canon. 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Wis 18:6-9 Heb 11:1-2, 8-19 Lk 12:32-48

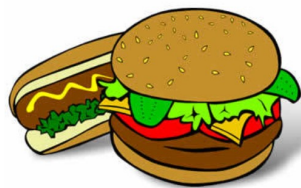

FROM THE Pastor's Desk

"Catholicism is not a prayer shawl we wrap around us on Sunday morning."

Being a Catholic does not mean just giving to God one brief hour on Sunday. It is a full-time job. One's religion must not be like a good Sunday suit that a person wears on Sunday morning and leaves hanging in the closet all the rest of the week. To be a true Catholic means **"to put on Christ"** always and everywhere. It means to walk with Christ every waking hour at home, at business, at recreation, wherever and whenever.

Christ must sit beside you at your desk, stand beside you at the counter where you wait on customers, ride beside you as you plow the field, be with you as you dust the furniture or change the babies dirty diaper. And more than that, His presence must radiate, not just from beside you; but also from your inner being.

You must constantly be aware of the presence of Christ in your daily life. He must not be worshipped only on Sunday and then shut out from the ordinary business of life, far more important than putting **"Christ back into Christmas"** - - is **putting Christ into our daily lives.**

This is what it means to be a true Catholic.

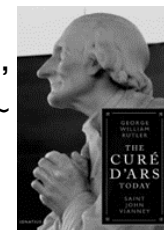

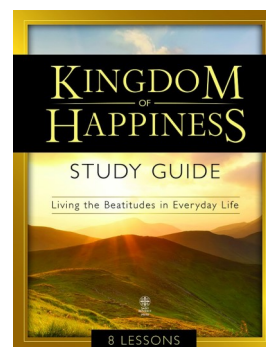
