Mass Readings for the week of August 11th: Mon., St. Jane Frances de Chantal, religious: Jane Fremiot, died 1641; wife of Baron de Chantal & mother of 6 children, 2 of whom died at birth; as a widow, with St. Francis de Sales, her spiritual director, she founded in 1610 the Visitation nuns; established some 85 monasteries before her death. Tues., Sts. Pontian, pope, & Hippolytus, priest, martyrs: Pontian, died 235; bishop of Rome banished by Maximinius Thrax to Sardinia where he was reconciled with Hippolytus; before dying, he abdicated his office to make way for his successor (1st pope to do so); buried in the cemetery of Callistus. Hippolytus, died 235/236; Roman priest & stern rigorist; 1st anti-pope; exiled to Sardinia with Pontian; source of Eucharistic Prayer II. Wed., St. Maximilian Kolbe, priest, martyr: Maximilian Mary Kolbe, died 1941 at Auschwitz by lethal injection; born near Lodz, Poland; O.F.M. Conv.; founded Militia of Mary Immaculate; missioned in Japan; offered his life in exchange for the father of a family. Thur., Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Fri., St. Stephen of Hungary: Stephen, died 1038; as the 1st Christian king of Hungary he united & Christianized the Magyar people; received the "holy crown" from Pope Sylvester II in 1000; renowned for his charity to beggars; known as the "Apostolic King & Apostle of Hungary." Sat., Weekday 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Jer 38:4-6, 8-10 Heb 12:1-4 Lk 12:49-53

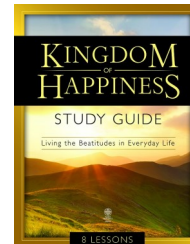
Marion (MN): Grades Pre-K-8—Classes meet Sundays 10:00-11:15 am, beginning Sunday, Sept. 22.
