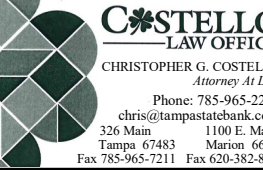
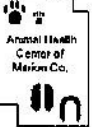

Mass Readings for the week of August 20th

Mon., St. John Eudes, priest: John Eudes, died 1680; founded the Congregation of Jesus & Mary, for training the clergy; also founded the Sisters of the Good Shepherd to assist morally endangered women, especially prostitutes; promoted cult to the Hearts of Jesus & Mary. **Tues., St. Bernard, abbot, doctor of the Church:** Bernard, died 1153; Cistercian abbot of Clairvaux; reformer & spiritual author; preached against the Albigensians; founded 68 monasteries; preached the 2nd Crusade; denounced injustice & worked for peace; patron of Gibraltar. **Wed., St. Pius X, pope:** Pius X, died Aug 20, 1914; undertook liturgical & canonical reforms, especially communion for children & frequent communion for adults; condemned Modernism; wished "to renew all things in Christ"; patron of sick pilgrims. **Thur., The Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary** Fri., St. Rose of Lima, virgin: Isabel Flores de Oliva, died 1617 at age 31; Peruvian mystic; nicknamed "Rosa" because of her beauty; O.P. tertiary who lived a life of penance & solitude, caring for the homeless, elderly, & sick; first declared saint of the New World; patroness of the Philippines & of South America, especially Peru; also of florists & gardeners. **Sat., St. Bartholomew, apostle:** Bartholomew, died 1st century; known as Nathaniel in John's Gospel; associated with St. Philip; said to have preached the Gospel in India & Armenia where he was flayed alive. 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time: Is 66:18-21 Heb 12:5-7, 11-13 Lk 13:22-30

Also, forms are available in the back of our Churches or can be printed off the Holy Family Parish website (hfpmc.org) under "Religious Education," then "Parish School of Religion." Medical release forms for **only new students** must be filled out this year. Return completed forms to your respective site coordinator. MONDAY NIGHT STUDY GROUP: The Monday Night Study Group invites men and women of the parish to join in a new session on Mon., Aug. 19th at the MAC at 6:30pm.
