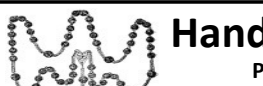
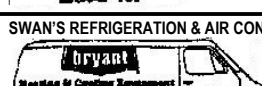

Mass Readings for the week of August 25th

Mon., Weekday **Tues., St. Monica:** Monica, died 387 at Ostia; born in Tagaste in Roman Africa; after 30 years of prayer, she obtained the conversion of her dissolute pagan husband; under the guidance of St. Ambrose, she won the conversion of her eldest son, St. Augustine; patroness of mothers.
Wed., St. Augustine, bishop, doctor of the Church: Augustine, died 430; born in Tagaste, north Africa; after a dissolute life, he received baptism at age 33 from St. Ambrose; elected bishop of Hippo; combatted Manichees, the Donatists, & Pelagius; most noted for his *Confessions* and *City of God*; over 500 homilies are extant; one of the 4 great doctors of the Latin Church; called the "Doctor of Grace."

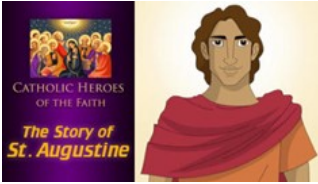

Medical release forms for **only new students** must be filled out this year. Return completed forms to your respective site coordinator. Online sign-up will also be conducted by the site coordinators for those who choose to do so. Also available online is the PSR calendar for this year. The Kick-off PSR Mass will be **Wed., Sept. 18th at Marion at 7pm**. The schedule and location of classes this year will be:

- Marion (MN):** Grades Pre-K-8—Classes meet Sundays 10:00-11:15 am, beginning Sunday, Sept. 22.
- Pilsen (PL):** Grades K-8—Classes meet Wednesdays 4:00-5:15 pm, beginning Sept. 25.
- Tampa (TM):** Grades 1-8—Classes meet Wednesdays 6:45-8:00 pm, beginning Sept. 25.
- High School TM/PL/MN:** Classes meet **Wednesdays** 7:00-8:30 pm in PL beginning Sept. 25: all H.S. boys - PL Church Basement; all H.S. girls - Laura Klenda's home in PL.
- Catholic Youth Ministry (CYM)** for High School will meet in MAC on the 1st Wednesday of each month, 7:00-8:30 pm.
