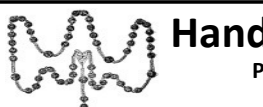

Mon., St. Peter Claver, priest: Peter Claver, died 1654; Catalan Jesuit who served in the Colombian mission in Cartagena; for 38 years devoted to caring for African slaves, baptizing over 300,000; called himself "the slave of the slaves forever"; patron of Colombia & of all missions to black peoples.

Tues., Weekday **Wed., Weekday** **Thur., The Most Holy Name of Mary** **Fri., St. John Chrysostom, bishop, doctor of the Church:** John Chrysostom, died 407; ascetic; became bishop of Constantinople; outstanding preacher (thus surnamed "golden mouthed"); defended the poor; sought reform of the clergy; twice exiled due to royal opposition; authored ascetical, apologetic, & polemical treatises as well as letters; one of the 4 great doctors of the Eastern Church; patron of preachers & of Istanbul (Constantinople).

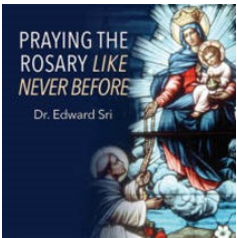

The Most Holy Name of Mary

"Blessed be the Name of the Lord for ever." The feast of the Holy Name of Mary (Sept. 12) follows just a few days after Mary's birthday (Sept. 8), just as the feast of Jesus' Holy Name (Jan. 3) follows His birthday, during the Christmas season. This makes sense: our name is officially given to us after our birth. When parents bring their child to the baptismal font, the priest asks them, "What name do you give this child?" For countless years, it's been the tradition that Christians—whenever a new child is born—name their child after one of the saints. It may be our first name, or our middle name, or both, but this is where our first patron saints come from. Our names are very important. It shows respect if we take the time to learn someone's name, and call him by his name. We do this when we pray to the saints, and especially to our Blessed Mother. Not just when we pray a memorized prayer, like the "Hail Mary", but whenever we pray to Mary, we start off by calling upon her by name. We say: "Mary, help me to be more kind to the person who tries my patience." Jesus called each one of us, when we were baptized, to be part of building His Church. If Jesus calls us by name, He has some work for us. So we call on the Name of Jesus each day, for Him to help us with our daily work, and upon the Name of Mary, that her prayers may help us to work in the Spirit of her Son.
