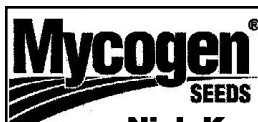

Mass Feastdays for the week of September 15th

Mon., Sts. Cornelius, pope, & Cyprian, bishop, martyrs: Cornelius, died 253 in exile in Civitavecchia; opposed Novatian & the rigorists in the *lapsi* controversy; buried in the cemetery of Callistus. Cyprian, decapitated 258 under Valerian; ally of Cornelius; bishop of Carthage; first African bishop to be martyred; patron of North Africa & of Algeria; both mentioned in the Roman Canon. **Tues., St. Robert Bellarmine, bishop, doctor of the Church:** Robert Bellarmine, died 1621; Tuscan; brilliant Jesuit scholar, preacher, writer, & systematic apologist of the Counter Reformation; cardinal archbishop of Capua; patron of catechists & catechumens. **Wed., Weekday** **Thur., St. Januarius, bishop, martyr:** Januarius, died c. 305; bishop of Benevento; as early as 1389, his blood has liquefied on this & other days each year; patron of Naples. **Fri., Sts. Andrew Kim Tae-gon, priest, & Paul Chong Ha-sang, & Companions, martyrs:** Andrew, born in Seoul, Korea, was a convert to the faith & was ordained Korea's first native priest. His father was a martyr. In 1846, Andrew was tortured & beheaded along with his lay associate, seminarian Paul Chong Ha-sang. Between 1839 & 1867, 103 martyrs gave their lives for the faith in Korea. **Sat., St. Matthew, apostle, evangelist**

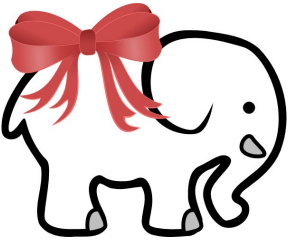

THE SIGN OF THE CROSS

Are we growing ashamed of the Cross of Christ? Is the custom of asking a blessing on ourselves before meals, before retiring, on awakening, in temptations, growing stale? Are we ashamed of wounding the susceptibilities of some non-Catholics or invoking their wrath or ridicule? "He that confesseth Me before men I will confess him before My Father, who is in Heaven." But blessing ourselves is a public confession of Jesus Christ. If we are ashamed to bless ourselves, we are ashamed of Jesus Christ.

We salute our country's flag. We are not ashamed of it. We glory in it. We publicly profess our faith in what it stands for.

The Cross is the flag of Jesus Christ. It is starred with His redeeming blood. It has wrapped Christianity in its swaddling bands. It has led the world's chivalry to deathless and unnumbered victories. That flag has been the shroud of countless soldiers who fell beneath its folds and slept in its embrace, sweetly as sleeps the child on its mother's breast.

That flag waves over the tomb, and will be hauled down only when the angel trumpet sounds the reveille. It will head the procession that our eyes will see coming down from heaven on the last day - the day of the grand review when the Great General will pin medals of honor on the breasts of some and badges of shame on others. Then it will lead us back to the camp in our Father's city; the King of Glory will wave His standard from afar, and when we, the faithful soldiers of Christ, shall have entered the City of God, that banner will be planted on the battlements of heaven, and will wave there in glory forever.
